SCIENCE

- · The children will be learning to describe animal bodies using relevant vocabulary.
- They will sort animals into simple groups, including groups based on animal diets.
- They will understand the difference between carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- · Be able to identify and classify animals by suggesting groups that they belong to
- Observe seasonal change.

ENGLISH

- Our English work will include several high quality text. During the writing learning journey this term we will explore new vocabulary from our topics and we will focus on writing a short narrative, fact file, riddle and diary. We will be focusing on sentences which will be punctuated by using capital letters and full stops.
- They will begin to understand how to use the suffixes and plurals -ed and ing. The children will be making their writing more interesting by using adjectives, conjunctions and different sentence openers. Daily phonics and reading will continue to be a focus.

COMPUTING

- Writing short algorithms and programs for floor robots and predicting program outcomes.
- Exploring object labels, then using them to sort and group objects by properties.

HISTORY

- The children will be learning about the history of Monarchs and their roles. They will learn about significant British monarchs and put them in order.
- The children will learn and compare the lives of Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria.
- They will also learn about the life of Lady Jane Grey.

DT

- The children will learn the importance of hygiene when preparing food. They will learn to prepare food safely.
- The children will create a healthy fruit salad.

PE

- In PE we will using the units of work from the PE Hub where we will be developing our hitting, running and defending skills.
- We will learn how to play games where we use these skills. We will be learning how to perform a variety of gymnastic moves.

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MATHS

· We will be learning about Self-portraits.

ART

- We will learn about the artists Picasso.
- We will learn how he used colour to portray how he was feeling and use that knowledge to create our own Picasso inspired artwork.
- The children will apply their knowledge of numbers to 20 with addition and subtraction.
- They will develop their understanding and knowledge of numbers to 50.
- · We will explore length, height weight and volume in our measurement unit.

MUSIC

- The children will be learning about Rhythm and to play along to pulse and maintain a steady tempo.
- The children will learn the difference between high and low pitched sounds and learn to recognise changes in pitch when singing and listening to musical sound

RE

- We will be learning about Jewish people and how they live.
- We will learn about special times and stories for Jewish people.

PSHE

- · We are learning about what it means to be healthy. We will learn about the importance of good hygiene, healthy diets and how medicines can help us.
- · We will also learn about moneyhow we can save it and how we spend it.

GEOGRAPHY

- The children will learn the four main points of a compass and use them to give and follow directions.
- The children will learn where England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales are on a map including their Capital cities
