COMPUTING

In computing, the children will be using a computer to create music. They will listen to a variety of pieces of music and think how it makes them feel, compare creating music and look at patterns. They will use and modify designs to create their own quiz questions in ScratchJr, using blocks of code.

PE

Attack, Defend and Shoot- The children will apply agility, balance and coordination to a range of ball skills. Participating in increasingly challenging games situations and be part of team games to develop simple tactics for attacking and defending. Run, Jump and Throw-The children will master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, balance, agility and co-ordination and participate in competitions.

SCIENCE

The children will build on their prior knowledge from Year 1 of plants. They will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. Find out and describe how plants to grow & stay healthy.

HISTORY

The children will be learning about The Great Fire of London. They will be learning about what, why, when, how and who it impacted. We will also learn what happened afterwards and how we remember the fire today.

DT

The children will explore and use mechanisms. They will select and use a range of tools and equipment to make successful vehicle.

Children will learn how to mix colours to create the Fire of London inspired art work. We will also be exploring shading and looking at the work of Stephen Wiltshire.

ART

Brocks Hill Primary School YEAR 2 SUMMER TERM

MUSIC

Pupils will be looking at music that makes you dance. They will reflect on how this music make us happy. We will also be exploring a range of instruments and musical scores to perform some of these ourself.

MATHS

In Maths, we will be looking at measure, time, position and direction and capacity over the summer term. Pupils will work practically and in books to explore a range of measurements and use these to solve problems. We will also be learning how to tell the time, as well as using this to work out the duration of events.

RE

In RE, we will be continuing our work on Christianity. We will be exploring forgiveness and why Christians ask for it. We will also be learning about the importance of helping each other and why this is a key building block to the Christian faith.

ENGLISH

Pupils will complete a variety of texts based around a series of fire of London novels and Samuel Pepys' diary.

PSHE

Children will learn about how they can keep their bodies healthy and reflect on their own lifestyle. We will look at the importance of the sun and being outside and how it makes us

feel. Pupils will then learn about their emotions, how to handle them, as well as accepting that they will change.

GEOGRAPHY

The children will learn how to locate cities, towns and villages on a map and label physical and human features found at each.

Children will also debate the advantages and disadvantages of living in a city by reflecting on their own experiences.
