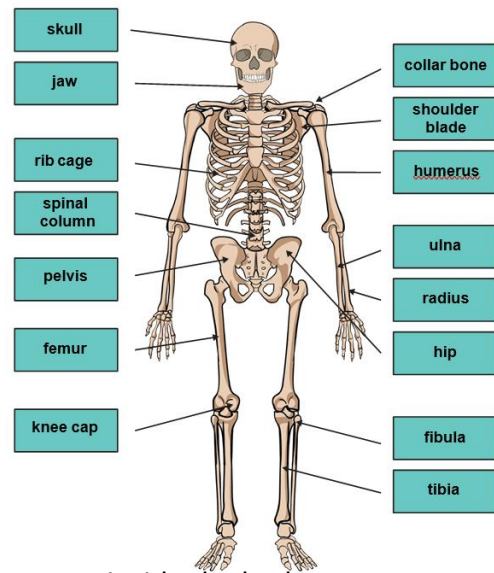


Skeletons

5.	Hydrostatic skeleton	A skeleton made up of a fluid-filled compartment in the body called a coelom, mainly found in softbodied animals
6.	Muscles	Soft tissues in the body that contract and relax to cause movement
7.	Nutrients	Substances that living things need to stay alive and healthy
8.	Energy	Strength to be able to move and grow
